Bag Making Boot Camp Supply List

1 to 1 1/4 yds of one sided fusible woven interfacing (I recommend Pellon SF101 Shape-flex fusible). If you are using cork for your bag, you will need 1/2 yd less of this since cork doesn't need interfacing.

1/2 yd cork or home dec fabric for exterior. You can also use quilting cotton, it will just produce a less firm bag. 1/2 yd quilting cotton for lining 1/4 yd quilting cotton for pocket lining (can be same as main lining) 1/2 yd. foam interfacing (I recommend Pellon FF77 Flex foam sew in - not fusible) sewing machine with zipper foot and walking foot **Microtex Sharp Needles** Scissors Seam Ripper - we will use this for something besides just mistakes! clover type clips Pins marking pen or chalk good sharp fabric scissors thread to match your exterior and lining fabrics whatever other normal sewing supplies you use when sewing If you have your own label, you may want to bring one to attach to your bag.

\$15.00 kit fee (to be paid to instructor in class) will include zippers, rivets and vinyl handles and purse feet.
